LEARNING AT HOME ON YOUR OWN	LEARNING AT HOME WITH LIVE INSTRUCTION	LEARNING IN SCHOOL
<p>When students are working remotely at home, the school day begins at 9:00 AM. Students are expected to be awake and ready to work at that time. At the start of the day, students working from home should do the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Log into TEACHHUB with your DOE email username and password. • Log into Google Classroom from TEACHHUB and check your classes for the work that you need to complete on your own. • Take note of when your teachers are hosting their virtual office hours and be sure to visit with them if you need additional support with the work. • Take note of when your teachers are running live instructional sessions. You must attend these sessions. Communicate with your teachers if you have difficulty with the time of the sessions. <p>During the morning, students should focus on class assignments that their teachers have assigned them to do on their own. This might include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Watching videos and responding to questions. • Reading texts and responding to questions or tasks. • Completing assessments or tasks in IXL. • Completing assignments in ThinkCERCA. • Working on individual parts of projects or other tasks as assigned by the teacher. 	<p>Students should take advantage of their teachers' live office hours to get additional support on the work that you'll have to complete on your own.</p> <p>During live instructional sessions, students should be prepared to do the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use the content knowledge that they gained by working individually to participate in small group discussions with peers. • Work collaboratively with peers to complete tasks assigned by the teacher. • Participate in whole-group discussions based on material learned individually. <p>It is EXTREMELY important that students complete their individual work to be able to effectively participate in their live instructional sessions.</p> <p>Students must maintain a daily routine to ensure that they are able to accomplish all of their assigned work. Students MUST participate in live sessions to get full credit for classes and maximize their learning.</p>	<p>Students will be participating in in-person instruction 2-3 days per week depending on the week if families have selected <i>Blended Learning</i>. If families selected <i>Remote Learning</i>, all learning will be done from home.</p> <p>In school, students will be expected to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be prepared by having completed all assigned remote tasks up to that day. • Be prepared with a notebook and pens/pencils. • Participate in group conversations to demonstrate their understanding and learning of course content. • Complete all tasks assigned by classroom teachers.

RCHS STUDENT 2020-21 IN-SCHOOL SAFETY AND HEALTH PROTOCOLS

ARRIVAL AND ENTRY	BATHROOM USE	IN-CLASS BEHAVIOR
<p>Students are expected to arrive by 7:45 AM to participate in our entry procedures.</p> <p>The most important aspect of students coming to school for classes is that they follow all of the safety protocols. Please review the safety protocols in the list below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will line up outside of the RCHS main entrance. Students must maintain social distancing while waiting to enter the school. • Masks must be worn at all times inside of the school building. Masks must also be worn while students wait to enter. Additionally, we <i>highly recommend</i> that students wear masks when they are travelling to school if they take mass transit. • A staff member will be at the door conducting random no-touch temperature checks. Students must present their student ID to the staff member at the door. The ID will have a colored sticker that indicates the days that students should be in school. If students have come to school on the wrong day, Department of Education guidelines indicate that the student must be sent home prior to entering the building. • Students will swipe their card at our scanning station. They will have the option to grab a breakfast and will be required to go directly to their assigned classroom. • In each classroom, there will be blue Xs on the floor. This is where all desks must remain for the duration of the school day unless otherwise directed by the teacher. 	<p>Students will be able to use the restroom throughout the day, although we recommend limiting restroom use when possible. Students must adhere to the following guidelines when leaving classrooms to use the rest room.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students must stand on the marked spots and maintain social distancing while waiting to use the restroom. • Students must present their ID card to the bathroom attendant prior to entering the bathroom. • Students must use hand sanitizer prior to entering the restroom. • Students must thoroughly wash their hands after using the restroom by following the guidelines as posted in the restroom. • Upon exiting the restroom, students must maintain social distancing and return directly to class. 	<p>Students will remain in their assigned classroom for the duration of their time in the school. Teachers will rotate in to support students in the tasks that they have been introduced to remotely. While in class, students:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May move their mask aside to take a drink. • May move their mask aside to eat a quick snack. • May not remove their mask • Must keep their desks on the marked spots. • May not violate social distancing guidelines. <p><i>Students MUST adhere to all safety guidelines at all times. If students DO NOT adhere to guidelines, they will be removed from the class. The student must be picked up by a parent or another family member on the Blue Card. They student will subsequently be moved from BLENDED to REMOTE LEARNING.</i></p>

Students will participate in specific tasks and engage in discussions with their peers.
11:45 AM – 12:30 PM	Students should take a break and have some lunch.	12:00 PM – 12:30 PM	Staggered dismissal of students. Students will have an opportunity to take a “grab-and-go” lunch as they exit the building.
12:30 PM – 2:45 PM	Students will participate in live instructional sessions run by their teachers. Attendance will be taken at these sessions.	12:30 PM – 2:00 PM	Students will travel home. If student commute is shorter, they should participate in afternoon live sessions run by their teachers.
2:45 PM – 3:30 PM	Students should take a break.	2:00 PM – 2:45 PM	Students should log in to participate in live sessions run by their teachers.
3:30 PM – 5:00 PM	Students should continue remote work on their own and complete any homework tasks. Students should prepare for in-person learning if they are on Blended Learning.	2:45 PM – 3:30 PM	Students should take a break.
5:00 PM – 11:00 PM	Play video games, talk to friends, listen to music, read a book, spend time with family. Students should do the things that help them unwind and relax.	3:30 PM – 5:00 PM	Students should continue remote work on their own and complete any homework tasks.
